



Policy on the processing of personal data pursuant to arts. 13 and 14 of the Regulation (EU) 2016/679

a) Data Controller and Contact Details

c) Purposes of the Processing and Legal Basis

The University of Turin is a public institution of higher learning conferred with tasks that have **institutional purposes relating to higher education and research** (art. 1 of the University of Turin Statuto), implementing art. 33 of the Italian Constitution.

The University of Turin will process the personal data for organizational and management purpose related to the event "Women in Mathematics Days" and in particular for:

- Organizing the Women in Mathematics Day event, held at Palazzo Campana, Via Carlo Alberto 10, in hybrid form, May 12, 2023, website "Women in Mathematics Day" meeting to awareness on the gender gap in STEM | University of Turin (unito.it)
- Perform live streaming on the website (<https://unito.webex.com/unito/j.php?MTID=mfa65c3bc8df9474aceb134441ab3d934>) and video recording of the event.

The University of Turin processes personal data for the performing a task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority vested in the data controller pursuant to art. 6(1) (e) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679. The legal basis, pursuant to art. 2 ter of Italian Legislative Decree no. 101 of 2018, consists of Italian Law no. 168/1989 as amended and supplemented and Italian Law 240/2010 as amended and supplemented

d) Types of data processed

The personal data collected and processed by the Controller for the purposes indicated above are the following:

- Personal details (first name, last name)

Please note that the video cameras and microphones of the auditors will be turned off by the organizers during the video recording of the event. At the end of the speakers' speeches, the auditors will be given the opportunity to turn on the video camera and microphone in order to ask any questions and make observations, after the video recording is stopped.

e) Provision of Data

Participation to the event "Women in mathematics days" is free and optional; non-participation does not entail any consequences for the interested party. Participation in the event by the interested participant implies the provision of the required personal data as described in paragraph d) of this policy.



f) Processing Methods

Your personal data will be processed by manual, IT and telematic means that are suitable, in any case, for ensuring the security and confidentiality of said data.

In order to achieve the aforementioned purposes, the data are processed within the University of Turin by subjects authorised to process data, under the responsibility of the Controller, who shall be adequately instructed and trained for this task.

The videos will be available for streaming to users of the website "Women in Mathematics Day" awareness meeting on the gender gap in STEM | University of Turin (united.it) and to those who explicitly request them from the organizers.

Data Processors

The data could also be communicated and processed by third-party providers of some services necessary for the execution of the processing, who act on behalf of the Controller for specific purposes of the service requested and who will be duly appointed “Processors” according to art. 28 of the Regulation (EU) 2016/679. In order to ensure the streaming participation of the conference, the CISCO Webex platform will be used. The Company providing this platform has been duly appointed as the external data processor pursuant to Art. 28 of the GDPR.

g) Categories of Personal Data Recipients

The Data Controller pays special attention in defining the organisation, the identification of staff appointed to collect data providing suitable instructions with regard to the methods for carrying out the processing activities, so as to ensure compliance with the ethical rules and protection of the rights of the data subjects.

h) Transfer of Personal Data to Third Countries

Personal data may be transferred to countries outside the European Union, as the Controller uses Google's services for the Educational sector. Google makes use of IT infrastructure, equipment necessary for the interconnection of networks and logging centers located in states outside the EU and for these services complies with the European legislation on data transfer as stated in the Amendment on the data processing, signed by the University, in which the standard contractual clauses are contained (see <https://cloud.google.com/terms/scs/eu-c2p>). Implementing Decision (EU) 2021/914 of June 4, 2021 the European Commission issued the standard contractual clauses for the transfer of personal data to third countries under Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council.

i) Data Retention Period

The personal data are stored for the time strictly necessary for pursuing the processing purposes (in compliance with the principle of necessity and processing purposes): and, therefore, are deleted at the end of two months starting from may 12th 2023.

Personal data may be retained for scientific research and/or statistical purposes even beyond the period necessary to achieve the purposes for which they were collected or subsequently processed, in accordance with Art. 5, § 1 letter e) and Art. 89 of the EU Regulation on the Processing of Personal Data 2016/679 (GDPR).



j) Rights Relating to Data
